


Sapele trees grow to over 135 feet with trunk diameters from 48-72 inches. The grain patterns include beautiful "cathedrals" (so named after Gothic church architecture). Natural Sapele flooring appears iridescent and seems to change color in different lighting.












3 Format Options

Midnight Oak






Hickory 1820 Janka





Jatoba is a tree common to the Caribbean, Central and South America. Although Jatoba is sometimes referred to as Brazilian or South American Cherry, it is not a cherry tree. Jatoba is a very hard wood that features a tan/salmon color with black accent stripes that over time turns to a deep rich red color.



The Ovengkol is an evergreen tree native to tropical west Africa. It grows to heights of 100 to 150 feet with trunk diameters of 24 to 36 inches. Its wood is heavy and dense and can be worked to a very smooth surface. These traits make it an ideal choice for cabinetry, musical instruments and flooring.

Wood is a natural product that changes color over time with exposure to light and other conditions. For this reason, the displayed samples in retail stores may vary in color from new product that is purchased.





It's the finishing touches that can make all the difference in any project. Robina Wood offers a complete line of coordinating trim pieces to help you provide a beautiful finish to your new floor installation.









1. T-molding

Transitions from wood to wood or another floor of equal height.

2. Baby threshold/square noseTransitions from wood to vertical surfaces such as carpet

or sliding glass doors.

3. Reducer

Transitions to a floor of lesser height such as vinyl.

4. Stair nose

Transitions at any stair edge or other step down location.

5. Quarter round

Transitions from the floor to the wall or baseboard.
